A	1	Replace AC unit at existing location. Reuse existing 240V 20A circuit (confirm condition and code compliance.) Place and level mounting pad. Mount and secure condenser to pad. Connect unit to control panel/existing thermostat. Connect condenser to power. Charge condenser with up to 12 lbs of R410a refrigerant. Power unit. Verify proper cycling and temperature control. Includes planning, equipment and material acquisition, area preparation and protection, setup and cleanup. *Work to be permitted and inspected. **10 yr. limited parts and 20 yr. manufacturer warranty required
A	2	Tub faucet in master bathroom shower is leaking. Correct leak by upgrading washers or mixer valve per your examination and recommendation.
A	3	Roof Troubleshoot: At rear of mobile home roof, where the edge of the roof meets an

		awning, water appears to be getting into the wall cavity and the kitchen. Correct leak by with flashing and or silicone coating per your examination and recommendation of the conditions.
