		drop. Wire and connect necessary circuits and breakers. Price to
		include planning, equipment and material acquisition, area
		preparation and protection, setup and cleanup.
		2. Replace or repair existing faulty circuits in following locations:
		(Contractor to include circuits, wiring, and outlets/switches to
		be replaced or added in estimate after inspection)
		3. Properly patch all damage to interior and exterior finishes.
		Texture and paint to match.
		Exclusions: Work does not require upgrade of all in home wiring, switches, and fixtures. Only replacing or adding what is needed to make system code compliant and safe. Work to be permitted and inspected



Exclusions: Any items not included in the above scope of work, including:

- a. Correction of existing unpermitted work not disclosed to Habitat or contractor;
- b. Costs related to temporary displacement of occupants;
- c. Costs related to storage of homeowner's belongings during duration of project.
