A	1	Tile roof repair: Tile on one side of the house is falling off edge. Will need broken tiles replaced and remaining tiles nailed in place and secured as needed. Use existing non broken to arrange and prevent any leaking in that area.
A	2	Kitchen Improvements: Countertop, sink and cabinet repair only. *Kitchen Materials Allowance: \$3000 Allowance includes finishing materials for cabinet repairs, cabinet hardware, countertops, backsplash materials, sink, plumbing fixtures a. Demo, haul and properly dispose of existing countertops, sink, faucet and disposal, and appliances. Any appliances being retained and reinstalled are to be moved and properly protected until reinstallation. b. Install new countertop and backsplash. Backsplash to be
