Program Process

1



Submit Interest Form

Submit online via our website, by email, over the phone, or by fax. Interest form will be reviewed to determine initial eligibility.

2



Submit Full Application and Supporting Documents

Submit by email, by mail, or fax. Our Program Administrator, Habitat for Humanity will provide confirmation of receipt. Tenant consent is required for rental units.

3



Eligibility and Approval

Habitat will review your full application and ask for any missing or additional information if needed.

4



Lead Inspection and Site Visit

Licensed professionals will test your home for lead-paint hazards. If lead-paint hazards are found, a second site visit and scope of work will be prepared to address the lead-paint hazards.

5



Project Approval

Property Owner will be sent program documents to sign.

6



Construction and Relocation

Habitat for Humanity will hire and oversee licensed professionals to do the work. Habitat for Humanity will provide relocation assistance during repairs if required. A licensed inspector will conduct a final inspection to confirm all lead-paint hazards have been addressed.
